## Introducing Joseph Steinberg, CEO of Christian Witness to Israel

Joseph Steinberg is committed to making the Good News of Jesus known to the Jewish people, wherever they may be found.

Raised in a Jewish home in the United States, as a teenager Joseph Steinberg shocked his family when he told them he believed Jesus is the promised Messiah. He came to that conclusion after searching for God in the Old Testament and through the faithful witness of a Christian friend. At the age of 18 Joseph was travelling the world as a missionary and in the space of two years had evangelised and performed in evangelistic concerts in 48 of the 50 states of the USA.

After graduating from the Moody Bible Institute's School of World Missions in Chicago, he served for three years as a missionary with CWI and for the last 25 years has worked with various churches and mission organisations in the UK.

Joseph is a graduate of Trinity College, Bristol and was ordained in the Church of England where he served as the minister of a parish church in London, UK. During that time he co-authored *The Y Course* and its companion book, *The Book of Y* – a seeker course used by over 6000 churches in the UK. He is also the author of *Psalms: Cries from the Heart* and the evangelistic booklet *That's Y Jesus came*.

While UK director of Jews for Jesus, Joseph led several large evangelistic campaigns in both London and Manchester, during which hundreds of people made professions of faith. He has served as the Director for Mission Stewardship at the Church Mission Society (CMS), yet another role which was driven by his passion to see lives changed by the gospel.

Joseph is a gifted and inspirational communicator. He has preached and shared extensively across the UK, including at both the Oxford and Cambridge Inter-Collegiate Christian Unions, and at hundreds of churches.
