Most EPTs have been meeting virtually during lock down, and until physical distancing lifts, it may continue to be the best option.

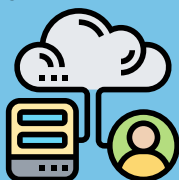
- Do all members have access to a quiet area for a video chat?

You could also explore a hybrid format to cater for everyone in your team.

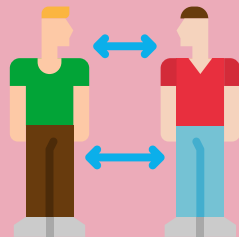
- Could you find a quiet cafe (perhaps one with a private room or floor) or a meeting room that you could book so some could meet in person, while others join virtually?

- Have you considered different time options to cater to changes in work schedules?
- Maybe you could meet as a group and walk together while you pray and encourage one another?
